<p>Punorjibon Rehabilitation Residential Centre for Boys This childcare centre caters for a unique, highly vulnerable and at-risk group of children with a history of substance abuse.</p>	<p>Funding Required €8,000</p>
<p>Crisis Intervention Centre for Boys Providing immediate care and protection to boys and young men who have been rescued from hazardous and dangerous situations on the streets of Kolkata.</p>	<p>Funding Required €2,000</p>
<p>Mother & Child Care Unit The MCCU is a short-stay home which provides safe shelter to mothers and their children who were abandoned by their families and/or experienced domestic abuse</p>	<p>Funding Required €22,000</p>
<p>Hope Hostel Education support and vocational training for young adults from other HOPE projects not yet restored to their families or are not fully independent at age 18.</p>	<p>Funding Required €34,000</p>
<p>Child Watch Provides care and protection to vulnerable children and works to build a strong bond between communities and education, protection and healthcare systems.</p>	<p>Funding Required €14,000</p>
<p>Food & Beverage Course - HOPE Café Provides skills training to underprivileged individuals, enabling them to earn an independent living and provide a sustainable pathway out of poverty.</p>	<p>Funding Required €9,000</p>
<p>Nabo Asha - New Market HOPE Nabo Asha centres provide underprivileged and disadvantaged children with education, healthcare and nutritional support.</p>	<p>Funding Required €7,000</p>
<p>Bhagar Creche Pre-primary education is provided to children aged 2-5 years in a fun, energetic and child-friendly environment.</p>	<p>Funding Required €8,000</p>

Night Round Medical Ambulance

Provides primary healthcare services to vulnerable street dwelling communities with no other access to healthcare, three nights a week.

Funding Required

€16,000

Prerona Residential Childcare Centre for Girls

At-risk girls are supported through the provision of healthcare, education, protection, counselling, nutrition and recreation activities.

Funding Required

€8,000

Umeed Special Education Project

Children with Special Needs are provided with care, protection, and educational supports to ensure their physical, social, and mental development.

Funding Required

€18,000

Naya Daur - Homeless Mental Health

A community-based project which supports homeless persons with psychosocial disabilities with the ultimate aim of family restoration.

Funding Required

€42,000
